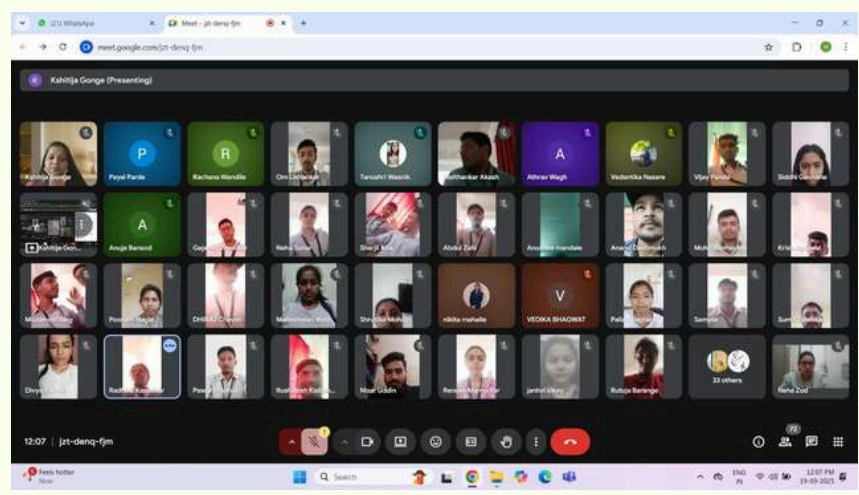
**DRGCOPA – State Level E-Poster Competition

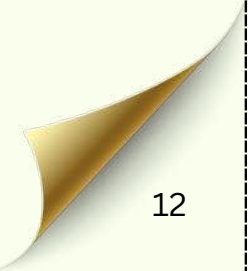
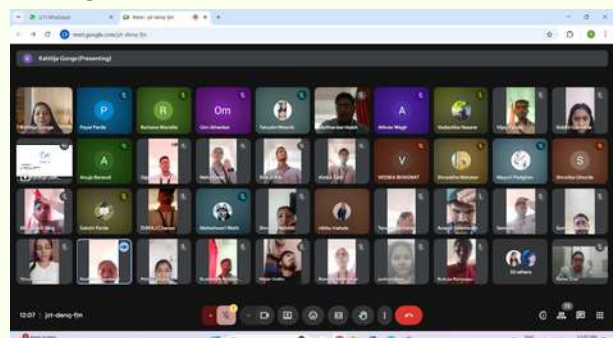

The seminar proved to be highly motivating and aligned with the institution’s commitment to holistic student development.





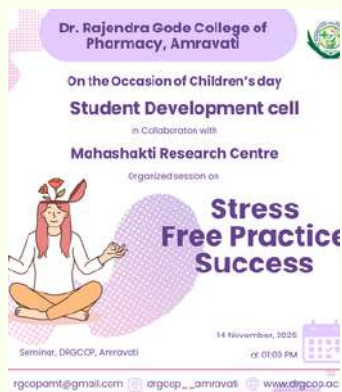
## DRGCOPA – Session on “Stress Free Practice Success” (Extra-Curricular | Co-Curricular Activity)

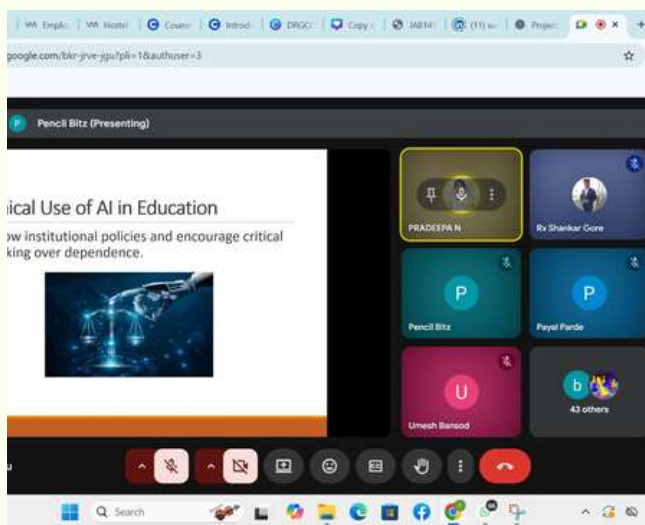

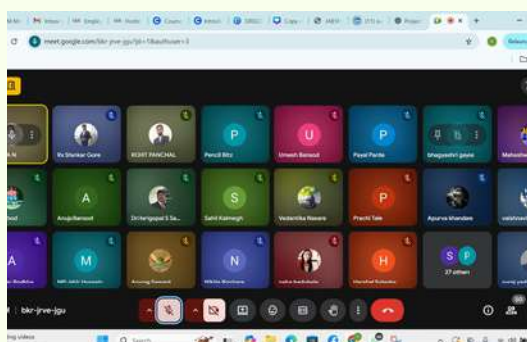
